20	(10) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article,
21	the department shall grant an automatic extension of time of

1	forty-five days for filing a return and remitting payment in

5	or other medical condition that adversely affects the health of
6	individuals or groups of individuals within this Commonwealth
7	and that is the subject of a declaration by the Governor of

9	general authority of Governor), including, but not limited to,
10	the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on
