## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621), entitled "An act to promote the health, safety and welfare of the people of the Commonwealth by broadening the market for 3 housing for persons and families of low and moderate income 4 and alleviating shortages thereof, and by assisting in the 5 provision of housing for elderly persons through the creation of the Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency as a public corporation and government instrumentality; providing for the 8 organization, membership and administration of the agency, 9 prescribing its general powers and duties and the manner in 10 which its funds are kept and audited, empowering the agency 11 12 to make housing loans to qualified mortgagors upon the security of insured and uninsured mortgages, defining 13 qualified mortgagors and providing for priorities among 14 tenants in certain instances, prescribing interest rates and 15 other terms of housing loans, permitting the agency to 16 acquire real or personal property, permitting the agency to 17 make agreements with financial institutions and Federal 18 agencies, providing for the purchase by persons of low and 19 moderate income of housing units, and approving the sale of 20 21 housing units, permitting the agency to sell housing loans, providing for the promulgation of regulations and forms by 22 the agency, prescribing penalties for furnishing false 23 information, empowering the agency to borrow money upon its 24 own credit by the issuance and sale of bonds and notes and by 25 giving security therefor, permitting the refunding, 26 27 redemption and purchase of such obligations by the agency, 28 prescribing remedies of holders of such bonds and notes, 29 exempting bonds and notes of the agency, the income therefrom, and the income and revenues of the agency from 30 taxation, except transfer, death and gift taxes; making such 31

- 1 bonds and notes legal investments for certain purposes; and
- 2 indicating how the act shall become effective," in general
- provisions, providing for suspension of interest payment
- 4 collection.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of December 3, 1959 (P.L.1688, No.621),
- 8 known as the Housing Finance Agency Law, is amended by adding a
- 9 section to read:
- 10 <u>Section 105. Suspension of Interest Payment Collection.--</u>
- 11 Notwithstanding any other law, beginning on the effective date
- 12 of this section and continuing until thirty days after the
- 13 termination or expiration under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating
- 14 to general authority of Governor) of the declaration of disaster
- 15 <u>emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at</u>
- 16 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of
- 17 <u>disaster emergency</u>, the agency may not collect interest in
- 18 connection with payments for loans otherwise collectible under
- 19 this act.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
