AN ACT

- Amending the act of August 7, 1963 (P.L.549, No.290), entitled "An act creating the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency; defining its powers and duties; conferring powers and 3 imposing duties on the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, 4 5 Superintendent of Public Instruction and the Department of 7 Auditor General; and making appropriations," providing for suspension of interest payment collection. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. The act of August 7, 1963 (P.L.549, No.290), referred to as the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance 12 Agency Act, is amended by adding a section to read: 13 14 Section 4.4. Suspension of Interest Payment Collection .--

- 3 connection with payments for loans otherwise collectible under_

- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
