- 1 Amending Title 12 (Commerce and Trade) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in small business first, further
- providing for definitions and for fund and accounts.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "small business" in section
- 7 2302 of Title 12 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
- 8 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to
- 9 read:
- 10 § 2302. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 12 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 * * *
- 15 "COVID-19 disaster emergency." The emergency declared by
- 16 proclamation of the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50
- 17 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of emergency.

- 2 "Small business." A person that is engaged in a for-profit
- 3 enterprise and that employs 100 or fewer individuals. The term
- 4 includes the following:
- 5 (1) An enterprise located in a small business incubator
- 6 facility.
- 7 (2) An agricultural processor.
- 8 (3) An agricultural producer.
- 9 (4) An enterprise which manufactures apparel products.
- 10 (5) An enterprise which is a for-profit or not-for-
- 11 profit child day-care center subject to licensure by the
- 12 Commonwealth.
- 13 (6) For the effective period of the COVID-19 disaster
- 14 <u>emergency</u>, an enterprise engaged in research and development.

- 16 Section 2. Section 2304 of Title 12 is amended by adding
- 17 subsections to read:
- 18 § 2304. Fund and accounts.
- 19 * * *
- 20 (e) Requirements for research and development enterprises. --
- 21 The terms of a loan made under this chapter to a small business
- 22 engaged in research and development may not include any of the
- 23 following requirements:
- 24 (1) That the small business maintain a minimum debt
- 25 service coverage ratio.
- 26 (2) That the small business provide a loan quarantee.
- 27 <u>(f) Waiver and adjustment.--For the effective period of the</u>
- 28 COVID-19 disaster emergency, the authority may enter into loan
- 29 agreements with eligible applicants as determined by the
- 30 <u>authority</u>. Subject to subsection (e), the authority is

- 1 <u>authorized to waive or adjust loan requirements and terms</u>,
- 2 <u>including applicant eligibility criteria</u>, <u>loan amounts</u>, <u>interest</u>
- 3 rates, collateral requirements, repayment periods and job
- 4 <u>creation or preservation requirements, for small businesses</u>
- 5 <u>located in the geographic area specified in the proclamation</u>
- 6 <u>declaring the disaster. The authority may accept applications</u>
- 7 <u>directly from eliqible applicants for loans and other financial</u>
- 8 assistance.
- 9 (g) Funds transfer. -- The sum of \$100,000,000 is
- 10 transferred from the Budget Stabilization Reserve Fund
- 11 <u>established in section 1701-A of the act of April 9, 1929</u>
- 12 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, to the authority
- 13 for the program under this chapter. Section 1703-A(b) of The
- 14 Fiscal Code does not apply to this subsection.
- 15 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
