- Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An

- establishing the SNAP Healthy Bucks Incentive Program. 4
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to 8
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 405.1C. SNAP Healthy Bucks Incentive Program. -- (a)
- 11 There is established in the department a program which shall be
- 12 known as the SNAP Healthy Bucks Incentive Program. The
- 13 department, in conjunction with the Department of Agriculture,
- shall administer the program. The program shall provide a 14
- 15 benefit reimbursement of fifty cents (50¢) to a SNAP participant
- for every one dollar (\$1) of SNAP benefits redeemed by the SNAP 16
- 17 participant for the targeted food items specified under
- 18 subsection (b).
- 19 (b) The targeted food items eligible for a benefit

- 1 reimbursement under the program must meet the criteria specified
- 2 <u>in the definition of "food" in section 3(k) of the Food and</u>
- 3 Nutrition Act of 2008 (Public Law 88-525, 7 U.S.C. § 2012(k))
- 4 and shall be any of the following:
- 5 (1) Fruits and vegetables, whether fresh, frozen or dried.
- 6 (2) A product under the act of April 28, 1937 (P.L.417,
- 7 No.105), known as the Milk Marketing Law.
- 8 (3) An agricultural commodity designated with the
- 9 <u>Pennsylvania Preferred® trademark.</u>
- 10 (c) Benefit reimbursements received under the program shall
- 11 <u>be capped per month for each SNAP eligible household as follows:</u>
- 12 (1) For households with no more than two individuals, forty
- 13 <u>dollars (\$40).</u>
- 14 (2) For households with no more than five individuals, sixty
- 15 dollars (\$60).
- 16 (3) For households with six or more individuals, eighty
- 17 dollars (\$80).
- 18 (d) The mechanism for delivering benefit reimbursements
- 19 under the program shall be determined by the department, in
- 20 conjunction with the Department of Agriculture.
- 21 (e) The department, in conjunction with the Department of
- 22 Agriculture, shall use all of the following for benefit
- 23 reimbursements under the program:
- 24 (1) Money appropriated by the General Assembly for benefit
- 25 reimbursements under the program.
- 26 (2) Any other money made available for benefit
- 27 reimbursements under the program by Federal appropriation,
- 28 donation or from any other source.
- 29 (f) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 30 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:

- 1 "Program" means the SNAP Healthy Bucks Incentive Program.
- 2 "SNAP" means the Federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance
- 3 <u>Program.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
