- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 providing for special education provisions. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 section to read: 11 Section 1501.9. Special Education Provisions. -- (a) The 12 13 Secretary of Education shall immediately issue a waiver to any 14 order by the Governor closing any public or nonpublic schools based on the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the

- 16 Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21,
- 2020), or any extension of that order to all public schools and 17
- 18 nonpublic schools to permit in-person special education services
- that comply with the individualized education program under the 19
- 20 Individuals With Disabilities Education Act (Public Law 91-230,

- 1 <u>20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.).</u>
- 2 (b) A public or nonpublic school shall adhere to social
- 3 <u>distancing practices and other mitigation measures defined by</u>
- 4 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention to protect from
- 5 and to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and any
- 6 recommendations of the Secretary of Health directing public
- 7 <u>health safety measures to maintain in-person special education</u>
- 8 <u>services</u>.
- 9 (c) A waiver issued under this section shall remain valid
- 10 notwithstanding any order issued under the declaration of
- 11 disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020,
- 12 published in 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), or any renewal of
- 13 the declaration of disaster emergency, unless the order removes
- 14 any of the restrictions or otherwise grants greater permissions
- 15 for operations than are provided under this section.
- 16 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 17 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 18 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 "Nonpublic school." A nonprofit school, other than a public
- 20 school within this Commonwealth, wherein a resident of the
- 21 Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school
- 22 attendance requirements of this act and which meet the
- 23 requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Public
- 24 <u>Law 88-352</u>, 42 U.S.C. § 2000 et seg).
- 25 "Public school." A school district, charter school, regional
- 26 <u>charter school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit or area</u>
- 27 <u>career and technical school in this Commonwealth.</u>
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
