AN ACT

Amending the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387), 1 entitled "An act prohibiting unfair methods of competition 2 and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the conduct of 3 any trade or commerce, giving the Attorney General and District Attorneys certain powers and duties and providing 5 penalties," further providing for definitions and for 6 unlawful acts or practices and exclusions. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2(4) of the act of December 17, 1968 11 (P.L.1224, No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and 12 Consumer Protection Law, is amended by adding a subclause to 13 read: Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act. 14 15 16 (4) "Unfair methods of competition" and "unfair or deceptive 17 acts or practices" mean any one or more of the following: * * * 18 19 (xxii) The assessment of fees by a financial institution for remote deposits or other remote transactions, or for automated 20

- 8 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
- 9 Section 3. Unlawful Acts or Practices; Exclusions.--Unfair
- 10 methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices
- 11 in the conduct of any trade or commerce as defined by subclauses
- 12 (i) through [(xxi)] (xxii) of clause (4) of section 2 of this
- 13 act and regulations promulgated under section 3.1 of this act
- 14 are hereby declared unlawful. The provisions of this act shall
- 15 not apply to any owner, agent or employe of any radio or
- 16 television station, or to any owner, publisher, printer, agent
- 17 or employe of an Internet service provider or a newspaper or
- 18 other publication, periodical or circular, who, in good faith
- 19 and without knowledge of the falsity or deceptive character
- 20 thereof, publishes, causes to be published or takes part in the
- 21 publication of such advertisement.
- 22 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
