(1) An applicant for an initial license to practice

medicine and surgery without restriction in this Commonwealth

shall request and submit to the board the results of a

national criminal history record check. The purpose of the

national criminal history record check shall be to assist the

board in obtaining information that may relate to the

applicant's fitness for licensure.

(2) An applicant for an initial license to practice

medicine and surgery shall submit to fingerprinting by the

Pennsylvania State Police or an authorized agent of the

Pennsylvania State Police. The Pennsylvania State Police or

an authorized agent shall submit the fingerprints to the

Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purposes of obtaining

records of criminal arrests and convictions.

the State of Principal License in accordance with the act of October 26, 2016 (P.L.891, No.112), known as the Interstate

Medical Licensure Compact Act, shall submit to fingerprinting

by the Pennsylvania State Police or an authorized agent of the Pennsylvania State Police. The Pennsylvania State Police or an authorized agent shall submit the fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purposes of obtaining records of criminal arrests and convictions to verify eligibility under the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Act. This paragraph shall not be construed to permit records obtained by the national criminal history record check to be submitted to the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact.

(4) In addition to the application fee, the applicant shall be responsible for any fees required by the

2	costs of the fingerprinting and the costs of conducting a
3	complete criminal history record check. The applicant shall
4	authorize the release of all records obtained by the criminal
5	history record check to the board.
6	(5) A criminal record check submitted in support of an
7	application for licensure must have been requested by the
8	applicant no earlier than 12 months immediately prior to the
9	board's receipt of the applicant's application for licensure.
10	(6) Information obtained from the criminal history
11	record check:
12	(i) Is confidential.
13	(ii) May not be redisseminated.
14	(iii) May be used only for the licensing purpose
15	authorized by this act.
16	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

27	THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE. THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT
28	FINGERPRINTS AND OTHER IDENTIFYING INFORMATION TO THE
29	PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE. THE MEMBER BOARD OF THIS STATE SHALL

- 2 (B) DUTIES OF PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE. -- IN ORDER TO ASSIST

- 4 BACKGROUND OF AN APPLICANT FOR AN EXPEDITED LICENSE, THE
- 5 PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE OR ITS DESIGNEE SHALL DO THE
- 6 FOLLOWING:
- 7 (1) PROVIDE THE MEMBER BOARD WITH A REPORT OF THE
- 8 <u>APPLICANT'S CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION AS DEFINED IN</u>
- 9 <u>18 PA.C.S. § 9102 (RELATING TO DEFINITIONS) OR A STATEMENT</u>
- 10 THAT THE PENNSYLVANIA STATE POLICE CENTRAL REPOSITORY
- 11 CONTAINS NO INFORMATION RELATING TO THE APPLICANT. THE
- 12 CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH
- 13 SHALL BE LIMITED TO ONLY THE INFORMATION AUTHORIZED TO BE
- 14 DISSEMINATED UNDER 18 PA.C.S. § 9121(B)(2) (RELATING TO
- 15 GENERAL REGULATIONS).
- 16 (2) SUBMIT THE APPLICANT'S FINGERPRINTS TO THE FEDERAL
- 17 BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY
- 18 RECORDS CHECK.
- 19 (3) PROVIDE THE MEMBER BOARD WITH THE NATIONAL CRIMINAL
- 20 HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION OF THE APPLICANT. THE INFORMATION
- 21 PROVIDED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO ONLY
- 22 THE INFORMATION AUTHORIZED TO BE DISSEMINATED UNDER 18
- 23 PA.C.S. § 9121(B)(2).
- 24 (C) USE OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION. -- CRIMINAL
- 25 HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION OBTAINED BY THE MEMBER BOARD OF THIS
- 26 STATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE INTERPRETED AND USED ONLY TO
- 27 <u>DETERMINE AN APPLICANT'S ELIGIBILITY FOR AN EXPEDITED LICENSE.</u>
- 28 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
