Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in fees, further providing for exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1901(c)(16) of Title 75 of the 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees. 8 9 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee. -- No 10 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any 11 12 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to 13 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the 14 registration: 15

(16) [Any] (i) Subject to adjustment under subparagraph

Bureau of Labor Statistics, for the previous 12-month period. The maximum amount as adjusted shall be rounded to the nearest multiple of \$1. The department shall submit notice of the new maximum amount to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
