## REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, JUNE 23, 2020

AN ACT
Providing for negative COVID-19 testing of hospital patients before admission to facilities and imposing duties on the Department of Health.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Short title.
This act shall be known and may be cited as the COVID-19 Long-Term Care Facility Safety Act.

Section 2. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
have the meanings given to them in this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
"COVID-19." As identified in the proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of disaster emergency.
"Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.
"Facility." Any of the following:
(1) A long-term care nursing facility as defined in section 802.1 of the act of July 19, 1979 (P.L.130, No.48), known as the Health Care Facilities Act.
(2) A personal care home as defined in section 1001 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code.
(3) An assisted living residence as defined in section 1001 of the Human Services Code.

Section 3. Negative COVID-19 testing requirement.
(a) General rule.--The department may not require a facility to admit a patient who is discharged from a hospital until the patient has tested negative for COVID-19.
(b) Regulations.--The department shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement this section. Section 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
