AN ACT

Amending Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions relating 2 to inmate confinement, providing for phone calls at State correctional institutions. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 61 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 8 9 § 5908. Phone calls at State correctional institutions. 10 (a) Primary caretaker parents. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a State inmate shall have the right to make, 11 without expense to the State inmate, one telephone call each 12 13 month to a child of the State inmate if, prior to incarceration: 14 (1) The State inmate was the primary caretaker of the 15 child. (2) The child lived with the State inmate. 16 (b) Construction. -- Nothing in this section shall be 17 construed as prohibiting other phone calls by State inmates in

- 2 (c) Applicability. -- This section shall not apply to a video
- 3 conference call.
- 4 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 6 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 7 "Child." An individual who is under 22 years of age.
- 8 "Primary caretaker parent." An individual who is a parent,
- 9 guardian or custodian of a child and provides more care to the
- 10 child than another parent, guardian or custodian of the child.
- 11 <u>"State inmate." An inmate of a State correctional</u>
- 12 institution.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
