AN ACT

Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in ethics in public contracting, providing for 2 definitions and for disclosure of contributions by 3 contractors. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 62 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding sections to read: 8 § 2301.1. Definitions. 10 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 11 12 context clearly indicates otherwise: "Affiliate." Any of the following: 1.3 (1) A parent, subsidiary or otherwise-affiliated entity 14 15 of an applicant or a contractor. 16 (2) An officer, director, associate, controlling shareholder, individual owner, partner or limited partner of 17

an applicant or a contractor.

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- 1 (3) An officer, director, associate, controlling
- 2 shareholder, individual owner, partner or limited partner of
- a parent, subsidiary or otherwise-affiliated entity of an
- 4 <u>applicant or a contractor.</u>
- 5 (4) A political committee controlled by an applicant or
- 6 a contractor.
- 7 (5) A political committee controlled by a parent,
- 8 <u>subsidiary or otherwise-affiliated entity of an applicant or</u>
- 9 <u>a contractor.</u>
- 10 (6) A lobbyist or lobbying firm identified on an
- 11 <u>applicant's disclosure statement or a contractor's updated</u>
- 12 <u>disclosure statement.</u>
- 13 "Applicant." A bidder, offeror or other person seeking a
- 14 contract, which is to be awarded under section 513 (relating to
- 15 competitive sealed proposals), 514 (relating to small
- 16 procurements), 515 (relating to sole source procurement), 516
- 17 (relating to emergency procurement), 518 (relating to
- 18 competitive selection procedures for certain services) or 519
- 19 (relating to selection procedure for insurance and notary
- 20 bonds).
- 21 "Elected official." An individual elected by the public to
- 22 serve a term in an elective office. The term shall include an
- 23 individual appointed to fill an unexpired term in an elective
- 24 office.
- 25 "Elective office." A position in a governmental body to
- 26 which an individual is required under the Constitution of
- 27 <u>Pennsylvania or by State law to be elected by the public.</u>
- 28 "Lobbying." As defined in 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A03 (relating to
- 29 <u>definitions</u>).
- 30 "Lobbying firm." As defined in 65 Pa.C.S. § 13A03.

2	"Reportable contribution." Any of the following:
3	(1) A contribution made by an applicant or a contractor
4	or an affiliate of an applicant or a contractor to:
5	(i) a candidate for nomination or election to an
6	elective office or to the candidate's political
7	<pre>committee;</pre>
8	(ii) an elected official or to the elected
9	official's candidate political committee; or
10	(iii) a political committee not described in
11	subparagraph (i) with the purpose and intent that the
12	political committee will, directly or indirectly, make
13	the contribution available to a candidate for nomination
14	or election to an elective office or to the candidate's
15	political committee, or to an elected official or the
16	elected official's candidate political committee.
17	(2) A contribution made by a person to a candidate for
18	nomination or election to an elective office or to the
19	candidate's political committee, or to an elected official or
20	to the elected official's candidate political committee, for
21	which a person who is an applicant or a contractor or any of
22	their respective affiliates acts as an intermediary.
23	§ 2304. Disclosure of contributions by contractors.
24	(a) Initial disclosure requirements
25	(1) A Commonwealth agency may not award a contract to an
26	applicant under section 513 (relating to competitive sealed
27	proposals), 514 (relating to small procurements), 515
28	(relating to sole source procurement), 516 (relating to
29	emergency procurement), 518 (relating to competitive
30	selection procedures for certain services) or 519 (relating

- to selection procedure for insurance and notary bonds),
- 2 unless the applicant has submitted to the Commonwealth agency
- a completed and signed disclosure statement that sets forth
- 4 <u>the information required under subsection (c) and is</u>
- 5 <u>otherwise in compliance with this section.</u>
- 6 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), an applicant
- 7 <u>shall submit a completed and signed disclosure statement to</u>
- 8 <u>the Commonwealth agency with other bid or proposal materials</u>
- 9 relating to the contract on or prior to the time and date
- 10 established by the Commonwealth agency for receipt of bids or
- 11 <u>proposals.</u>
- 12 (3) For contracts awarded under section 514, 515 or 516
- that do not require the submission of bids or offers, an
- 14 applicant shall submit a completed disclosure statement as
- directed by the Commonwealth agency, but prior to the
- 16 <u>Commonwealth agency's award of the contract.</u>
- 17 (4) A bid or offer made without a completed and signed
- 18 disclosure statement may not be considered a responsive bid
- or offer.
- 20 (b) Requirements to update disclosures.--
- 21 (1) During the term of the contract and for one year
- thereafter, a contractor who has been awarded a contract
- 23 under section 513, 514, 515, 516, 518 or 519 shall submit an
- 24 updated disclosure statement to the Commonwealth agency
- 25 within five days following making a reportable contribution
- or learning that an affiliate has made a reportable
- 27 contribution. An updated disclosure statement shall include
- 28 the reportable contributions made since the date of the first
- 29 disclosure statement submitted.
- 30 (2) A contract awarded under section 513, 514, 515, 516,

- 1 518 or 519 must contain a provision requiring the contractor
- 2 to submit an updated disclosure statement as required under
- 3 <u>paragraph (1).</u>
- 4 <u>(c) Form of disclosure statements.--</u>
- 5 <u>(1) The department shall develop a form of disclosure</u>
- 6 statement to be used by applicants and contractors under this
- 7 section.
- 8 (2) The invitations for bids, requests for proposals and
- 9 <u>other Commonwealth agency communications with prospective</u>
- 10 contractors regarding a contract awarded under section 513,
- 11 514, 515, 516, 518 or 519 must include a disclosure statement
- 12 <u>form and information regarding the disclosure requirements of</u>
- this section.
- 14 (3) The department and the Department of State shall
- post the disclosure statement form and information regarding
- the disclosure requirements of this section on their
- 17 respective publicly accessible Internet websites and shall
- 18 otherwise make the forms and information available upon
- 19 request.
- 20 (d) Content of disclosure statements and updates. -- A
- 21 disclosure statement submitted under subsection (a) shall
- 22 include the following information:
- 23 (1) The name, business address and telephone number of
- the applicant or contractor.
- 25 (2) The contract number or other identifying information
- 26 regarding the contract sought by the applicant or awarded to
- 27 <u>the contractor.</u>
- 28 (3) The names, business addresses and telephone numbers
- of the lobbyists and lobbying firms paid by the applicant to
- 30 lobby a Commonwealth agency to influence the awarding of a

1 <u>contract within one year prior to the date of an applicant's</u>

2 <u>bid, offer or proposal.</u>

(4) A list of the reportable contributions made within one year prior to the date of the applicant's bid, offer or proposal. For each reportable contribution made, the applicant shall identify the recipient of the contribution and the date and amount of the contribution.

of the applicant's affiliates within one year prior to the date of the applicant's bid, offer or proposal for the purpose of soliciting or receiving reportable contributions and the date and amount of reportable contributions solicited or received at each event. An updated disclosure statement shall be submitted during the term of a contract within five days following a fundraising event described in this paragraph hosted by a contractor or an affiliate of a contractor.

- (6) The name, business address and telephone number of all subcontractors which the applicant intends to use on the contract or which the contractor is using on the contract.

 (e) Posting of disclosure statements and updates.--
- (1) A Commonwealth agency shall promptly transmit to the

 Department of State a copy of the disclosure statement and

 each updated disclosure statement it receives from an

 applicant or a contractor under this section.
- (2) The Department of State shall post each disclosure
 statement and each updated disclosure statement received
 under this section on its publicly accessible Internet
 website no later than five days after the disclosure
 statement or update has been received by the department. A

- 1 disclosure statement and related updates shall remain posted
- 2 for a period of time encompassing the length of the contract
- 3 and one year thereafter. To the extent practicable, a
- 4 <u>disclosure statement and related updates shall be posted</u>
- 5 <u>together.</u>
- 6 (3) The Department of State shall make disclosure
- 7 <u>statements and updated disclosure statements received under</u>
- 8 <u>this section available for public inspection and copying.</u>
- 9 (f) Penalties. -- In addition to other penalties that may be
- 10 assessed under other law, an applicant or a contractor who makes
- 11 a material misstatement or omission in a disclosure statement or
- 12 an updated disclosure statement may be debarred or suspended
- 13 <u>under section 531 (relating to debarment or suspension).</u>
- 14 (q) Application of section. -- This section shall apply to a
- 15 bid, offer or proposal that is solicited on or after the
- 16 effective date of this section.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
