Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 8 § 4307. Domestic violence in the presence of a minor. 10 (a) General rule. -- The commission of any of the following offenses against a family or household member in the presence of 11 a child 18 years of age or under shall be a misdemeanor of the 12 13 first degree: (1) An offense under Chapter 25 (relating to criminal 14 homicide). 15 16 (2) Section 2504 (relating to involuntary manslaughter). 17 (3) Section 2701 (relating to simple assault). (4) Section 2702(a)(3), (4) and (5) (relating to 18

- 4 (6) Section 2706 (relating to terroristic threats).

- 7 (b) Separate offense. -- An offense under subsection (a) shall
- 8 <u>be separate from the underlying offenses listed under subsection</u>
- 9 (a) (1) through (8).
- 10 <u>(c) Presence.--For the purposes of this section, presence</u>
- 11 shall mean in the view or hearing of the child.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
