A person or entity, other than a public entity, 3 may not make a claim for a prescriptive easement for the benefit 4 of the public. 5 6 Section 3. The addition of the definitions of "local agency" and "public entity" in section 2 of the act and section 7.1 of 7 8 the act shall apply retroactively to a claim which arose within

9 21 years of the effective date of this section.

10 Section 4. The Department of Conservation and Natural 11 Resources shall be substituted for the person or entity, other 12 than a public entity, making a claim for a prescriptive easement 13 for the benefit of the public in any litigation pending on or 14 after the effective date of this section.

15 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
