AN ACT

Amending Title 45 (Legal Notices) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in legal advertising, providing for 2 methods for advertising. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 45 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7 § 311. Methods for advertising. 8 9 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of 10 law or regulation, whenever an advertisement or notice is required by law, rule or regulation, a local government unit 11 shall satisfy the requirement by using one of the following 12 13 methods: 14 (1) A newspaper of general circulation as defined in 15 section 101 (relating to definitions) printed in the county 16 in which the government unit is located. (2) A newspaper printed in the government unit, if there 17

is such a newspaper.

- 1 (3) A newspaper circulating generally in the government
- 2 unit.
- 3 <u>(4) A legal newspaper designated by the rules of court</u>
- 4 of the county in which the government unit is located for the
- 5 <u>publication of legal notices and advertisements.</u>
- 6 (5) The government unit's official, publicly accessible
- 7 <u>Internet website using hypertext markup language (HTML)</u>
- 8 <u>format or an equivalent language format.</u>
- 9 (6) The official, publicly accessible Internet website
- of a newspaper listed in paragraph (1), (2), (3) or (4),
- 11 <u>using HTML format or an equivalent language format.</u>
- 12 (7) A community paper of mass dissemination.
- (b) Additional requirements. -- Using an option under
- 14 <u>subsection</u> (a) to satisfy the requirement to publish an
- 15 advertisement or notice required by law, rule or regulation does
- 16 not relieve a government unit of the requirement to publish in a
- 17 legal journal if otherwise required under section 308 (relating
- 18 to additional publication in legal journals) or any other
- 19 provision of law.
- 20 (c) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 21 "community paper of mass dissemination" means a locally
- 22 circulated printed publication that is at least four pages long,
- 23 is issued on at least a weekly basis and is distributed by
- 24 <u>audited carriers to all known addresses within a political</u>
- 25 subdivision.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
