## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in duties and powers of boards of 5 school directors, providing for code of ethics and 6 professional responsibility for teachers. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: 1.3 Section 529. Code of Ethics and Professional Responsibility for Teachers. -- (a) Each board of school directors shall 14 15 establish a code of ethics and professional responsibility for teachers which provides that no public elementary or secondary 16 17 school teacher, regardless of continuing contract status, is 18 permitted during class time or while otherwise operating within 19 the scope of employment as a teacher to do the following: 20 (1) endorse, support or oppose any Federal, State or local legislation or regulation, regardless of whether the legislation 21

- 1 or regulation is pending, proposed or enacted;
- 2 (2) endorse, support or oppose a Federal, State or local
- 3 court case or judicial action, regardless of whether the court
- 4 <u>case or judicial action is pending, proposed or decided;</u>
- 5 (3) endorse, support or oppose a pending, proposed or final
- 6 <u>executive action by a Federal, State or local executive branch</u>
- 7 agency;
- 8 (4) endorse, support or engage in activities that hamper or
- 9 impede the lawful access of military recruiters to school
- 10 property; or
- 11 (5) endorse, support or engage in activities that hamper or
- 12 <u>impede the actions of a Federal, State or local law enforcement</u>
- 13 <u>agency</u>.
- 14 (b) A code of ethics and professional responsibility for
- 15 <u>teachers established under subsection (a) shall contain</u>
- 16 provisions for enforcement and penalties for a violation of the
- 17 prohibitions in the code of ethics and professional
- 18 responsibility, up to and including termination of employment.
- 19 (c) Each board of school directors shall provide the
- 20 following:
- 21 (1) Written notification of the code of ethics and
- 22 professional responsibility for teachers that is established
- 23 under subsection (a) to all public elementary and secondary
- 24 school teachers and enrolled students and parents of enrolled
- 25 students.
- 26 (2) At least one hour of annual continuing teacher education
- 27 <u>instruction regarding a teacher's responsibilities under a code</u>
- 28 of ethics and professional responsibility.
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
