1 2 3 4	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in COVID-19 disaster emergency, providing for notice of change shortage and retail implications.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 5703. Notice of change shortage and retail implications.
10	All retailers in this Commonwealth must provide notice of
11	preferred payments for retail items in a conspicuous location of
12	the retail location, including notice as to whether exact change
13	from a cash transaction can be provided to the customer. The
14	following shall apply:
15	(1) If a retailer cannot provide exact change to a
16	customer, the retailer may issue a store credit or gift card
17	in the amount of the difference between the transaction total
18	and the cash change amount the retailer is deficient.

1	(2) If a retailer does not issue a store credit or gift
2	card under paragraph (1), the retailer must round the
3	transaction total down to the nearest dollar, after tax, if
4	any.
5	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
