AN ACT

- 1 Authorizing the Department of General Services, with the
- approval of the Governor, to grant and convey to Human
- 3 Services, Inc., certain lands and improvements situate in the
- Borough of West Chester, Chester County.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Conveyance in Borough of West Chester, Chester
- 8 County.
- 9 (a) Authorization. -- The Department of General Services, with
- 10 the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized and directed
- 11 on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to grant and
- 12 convey, for \$1.00, the following tracts of land together with
- 13 any buildings, structures or improvements thereon, situate in
- 14 the Borough of West Chester, Chester County to Human Services,
- 15 Inc.
- 16 (b) Property description. -- The property to be conveyed under
- 17 subsection (a) consists of two approximately .15-acre tracts of
- 18 land and improvements located thereon, bounded and more

- 1 particularly described as follows:
- 2 ALL THOSE two certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land,
- 3 situate, lying and being in the Borough of West Chester, County
- 4 of Chester and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and
- 5 described as follows, to wit:
- 6 FIRST PARCEL
- 7 BEGINNING at a point in the north street line of Price Street
- 8 (sixty feet wide at the distance of 168.81 feet measured south
- 9 68 degrees 40 minutes west along the said north street line of
- 10 Price Street, from its intersection with the west street line of
- 11 Church Street (fifty-five feet wide); extending thence from said
- 12 beginning point along the said north street line of Price Street
- 13 south 68 degrees 40 minutes west 25.32 feet to a point; thence
- 14 extending north 21 degrees 20 minutes west, passing partly
- 15 through the center line of a party wall between these premises
- 16 and the premises adjoining to the southwest; 143.89 feet to a
- 17 point; thence extending north 68 degrees 15 minutes 30 seconds
- 18 east 25.32 feet to a point; thence extending south 21 degrees
- 19 20 minutes east 144.07 feet to the first mentioned point and
- 20 place of beginning;
- 21 BEING known for street address purposes as 113 Price Street,
- 22 West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania.
- 23 SECOND PARCEL
- 24 BEGINNING at a point on the north street line of Price Street
- 25 (sixty feet wide) at the distance of 194.13 feet measured south
- 26 68 degrees 40 minutes west along the said north street line of
- 27 Price Street, from its intersection with the west street line of
- 28 Church Street (fifty-five feet wide); extending thence from
- 29 said beginning point along the said north street line of Price
- 30 Street south 68 degrees 40 minutes west 25.31 feet to a point;

- 1 thence extending north 21 degrees 20 minutes west 143.71 feet to
- 2 a point; thence extending north 68 degrees 15 minutes 30
- 3 seconds east 25.31 feet to a point; thence extending south 21
- 4 degrees 20 minutes east passing partly through the center line
- 5 of party wall between these premises and the premises adjoining
- 6 to the northeast 143.89 feet to the first mentioned point and
- 7 place of beginning.
- 8 BEING known for street address purposes as 115 Price Street,
- 9 West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania.
- 10 BEING UPI Number 1-9-1007-E.
- BEING the same premises which Delco Holding Company, by its
- 12 deed dated May 28, 1953 and recorded on May 28, 1953 in the
- 13 office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Chester County,
- 14 Pennsylvania in Deed Book Q-24, page 212, granted and conveyed
- 15 unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in fee.
- 16 (c) Requirement for conveyance. -- The conveyance shall be
- 17 made under and subject to all lawful and enforceable easements,
- 18 servitudes and rights of others, including but not confined to
- 19 streets, roadways and rights of any telephone, telegraph, water,
- 20 electric, gas or pipeline companies, as well as under and
- 21 subject to any lawful and enforceable estates or tenancies
- 22 vested in third persons appearing of record, for any portion of
- 23 the land or improvements erected thereon.
- 24 (d) Gaming restriction. -- A conveyance authorized under this
- 25 section shall be made under and subject to the condition, which
- 26 shall be contained in the deed of conveyance, that no portion of
- 27 the property conveyed shall be used as a licensed facility, as
- 28 defined in 4 Pa.C.S. § 1103 (relating to definitions), or any
- 29 other similar type of facility authorized under State law. The
- 30 condition shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be

- 1 binding upon the Grantee, its successors and assigns. Should
- 2 the Grantee, its successors or assigns, permit any portion of
- 3 the property authorized to be conveyed in this act to be used in
- 4 violation of this subsection, the title shall immediately revert
- 5 to and revest in the Grantor.
- 6 (e) Covenants, conditions and restrictions. -- The Secretary
- 7 of General Services may impose any covenants, conditions,
- 8 restrictions and/or reservations on the sale of the property as
- 9 is deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth of
- 10 Pennsylvania.
- 11 (f) Deed.--The conveyance shall be by special warranty deed
- 12 and shall be executed by the Secretary of General Services in
- 13 the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 14 (g) Costs and fees. -- All costs and fees incurred by the
- 15 Department of General Services shall be borne by the Grantee.
- 16 (h) Alternate disposition. -- In the event that an Agreement
- 17 of Sale is not executed between the Department of General
- 18 Services and the aforementioned Grantee within two years after
- 19 the effective date of this act, the property may be disposed of
- 20 through a public bidding process.
- 21 (i) Proceeds.--All proceeds from the sale of the property
- 22 shall be deposited into the General Fund.
- 23 Section 2. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
