AN ACT

Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in COVID-19 disaster emergency, imposing a moratorium on evictions and foreclosures; and, in Commonwealth services, further providing for general 4 authority of Governor. 5 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 8 Section 1. Chapter 57 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subchapter to read: 10 SUBCHAPTER F 11 MORATORIUM ON EVICTIONS AND FORECLOSURES 12 § 5751. Imposition of moratorium. 13 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of 14 law, residential evictions and foreclosures are suspended during 15 the COVID-19 disaster emergency. The moratorium period shall 16 extend until December 31, 2020.

(b) Applicability. -- The moratorium under subsection (a)

- 2 commenced between August 31, 2020, and the effective date of

- 4 (c) Construction. -- Nothing in this section shall be
- 5 construed to limit the Governor's authority or powers under
- 6 Chapter 73 (relating to Commonwealth services).
- 7 Section 2. Section 7301(f) of Title 35 is amended by adding

- 9 § 7301. General authority of Governor.

- 11 (f) Additional powers. -- In addition to any other powers
- 12 conferred upon the Governor by law, the Governor may:

- 14 (10) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, place
- 15 <u>a moratorium on evictions and foreclosures in this</u>
- 16 <u>Commonwealth or specific counties during a disaster</u>
- 17 emergency. A moratorium enacted under this paragraph shall
- 18 <u>extend for 90 days after the disaster emergency has expired</u>
- 19 or been terminated, unless sooner rescinded by the Governor.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
