## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole 1 2 authority for regulating the display of the flag of the 3 United States from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," providing 5 for display of the Honor and Remember Flag; and making an 6 editorial change. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The title of the act of March 4, 1970 (P.L.128, 11 No.49), entitled "An act granting to the Governor of the 12 Commonwealth the sole authority for regulating the display of 13 the flag of the United States from any public ground or building 14 and from any ground or building of certain other institutions," 15 is amended to read: 16 AN ACT 17 Granting to the Governor of the Commonwealth the sole authority 18 for regulating the display of [the flag of the United States] 19 flags from any public ground or building and from any ground or building of certain other institutions. 20

- 1 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 2 <u>Section 1.1. Notwithstanding section 3 of the act of June</u>
- 3 30, 2011 (P.L.85, No.19), known as the Honor and Remember Flag
- 4 Act, the Governor of the Commonwealth shall have the sole power
- 5 and duty for regulating the display of the Honor and Remember
- 6 Flag from any public ground or building of the Commonwealth, of
- 7 any board, commission or authority of the Commonwealth created
- 8 by the General Assembly, of any political subdivision of the
- 9 <u>Commonwealth</u>, of any school district of the Commonwealth or from
- 10 any ground or building of any institution which receives any
- 11 State aid from the Commonwealth. The Governor shall have the
- 12 power and duty to promulgate rules and regulations pursuant to
- 13 the provisions of this section.
- 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
