AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and 5 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 6 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 7 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in 16 Pennsylvania liquor stores, further providing for sales by 17 18 Pennsylvania liquor stores; and abrogating a regulation. 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 20 hereby enacts as follows: 21 Section 1. Section 305 of the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, 22 No.21), known as the Liquor Code, is amended by adding a 23 subsection to read: 24 Section 305. Sales by Pennsylvania Liquor Stores. -- * * 25 (b.2) Notwithstanding subsection (b), for a period of one

- 1 year beginning January 1, 2021, sales to licensees, except for
- 2 special liquor orders, shall be made at a price that includes a
- 3 <u>discount of twenty per centum of the retail price.</u>

- 5 Section 2. The regulation at 40 Pa. Code § 11.5(a) (relating
- 6 to issuance of wholesale liquor purchase permit cards) is
- 7 abrogated insofar as it reads "if the retail cost of the order
- 8 is \$50 or more"
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
