- This chapter relates to the production, processing,
- 16 transportation, distribution and sale of hemp extract.
- 17 § 1702. Definitions.
- 18 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 3 "Hemp extract." Any product made or derived from industrial
- 4 hemp, and any part of such plant, including the seeds thereof
- 5 and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids,
- 6 <u>salts</u>, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a
- 7 <u>delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than an</u>
- 8 <u>amount of the plant Cannabis sativa L.</u>
- 9 <u>§ 1703. Regulations.</u>
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other law to the
- 11 contrary, industrial hemp may be produced, processed,
- 12 transported, distributed and sold in a manner consistent with
- 13 the regulations promulgated under subsection (b) and all Federal
- 14 <u>laws</u>, regulations and orders.
- 15 (b) Regulations. -- The department shall promulgate rules and
- 16 regulations governing the production, processing,
- 17 transportation, distribution and sale of hemp extract in this
- 18 Commonwealth.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
