Commission members. 8 9 Selection. -- The commission shall be composed of 20 10 members as follows: 11 The following members shall serve by virtue of their office: 12 13 The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State 14 Police who shall serve as chairman of the commission. 15 The Secretary of Community and Economic (ii) 16 Development. 17 (iii) The Attorney General.

- 4 (2) The following members shall be appointed by the

- 8 (ii) A member of the House of Representatives.
- 9 (3) The following members shall be appointed by the 10 Governor.
- (i) A borough official, a first class township

 official, a second class township official and a city

 official.
- (ii) Four incumbent chiefs of police from the
 various municipalities of this Commonwealth, at least one
 to be a chief of a borough police department, at least
 one to be a chief of a township police department and at
 least one to be a chief of a city police department.
 - [(iii) One Federal Bureau of Investigation special agent-in-charge.]
- 21 (iv) One educator qualified in the field of law enforcement.
- 23 (v) One member representing the public at large.
- 24 (vi) Two noncommissioned police officers.
- 25 (vii) A director of one of the certified training
- schools.
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28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
