AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in terms and course of study, 5 providing for sports and extracurricular activities during 6 COVID-19 pandemic. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11 12 section to read: 13 Section 1501.10. Sports and Extracurricular Activities 14 During COVID-19 Pandemic.--(a) Notwithstanding any other 15 provision of law, withing fifteen (15) days of the effective
- 16 date of this section, each governing authority of a school
- 17 entity shall meet and vote, by a majority, whether to adopt a
- 18 policy to hold school sports activities, including competitions,
- 19 <u>intramural play and scrimmages</u>, and other in-person
- 20 <u>extracurricular activities during the 2020-2021 school year.</u>

- 1 (b) If a governing authority of a school entity votes, by a
- 2 <u>majority</u>, and adopts a policy allowing school sports activities
- 3 <u>under subsection (a), the governing authority of a school entity</u>
- 4 <u>shall develop and vote, by a majority, on an athletic, health</u>
- 5 and safety plan addressing school sports and other in-person
- 6 <u>extracurricular activities during the 2020-2021 school year. A</u>
- 7 governing authority of a school entity shall determine and
- 8 <u>include the following in the plan:</u>
- 9 (1) Safety protocols for permitting visitors and spectators
- 10 to attend sports and in-person extracurricular activities.
- 11 (2) Limits on gatherings for indoor and outdoor sports and
- 12 in-person extracurricular activities to ensure social
- 13 <u>distancing</u>, which may not exceed fifty (50) percent of the
- 14 <u>capacity of the facility.</u>
- 15 (3) Protocols for sports consistent with the Centers for
- 16 <u>Disease Control and Prevention Considerations for Youth Sports.</u>
- 17 (4) Methods of ensuring that social distancing, face
- 18 coverings and other safety measures recommended by the Secretary
- 19 of Health are in place for students, staff and spectators.
- 20 (c) A governing authority of a school entity shall post the
- 21 <u>athletic</u>, <u>health</u> and <u>safety plan on its publicly accessible</u>
- 22 Internet website and submit the plan to the department of
- 23 Education and the Department of Health. A governing authority of
- 24 a school entity may amend the athletic, health and safety plan
- 25 as needed, any amended plan must be submitted to the Department
- 26 of Education and the Department of Health.
- 27 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 28 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 29 <u>the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 30 "School entity." A school district, nonpublic school,

- 1 <u>intermediate unit</u>, area career and technical school, charter
- 2 <u>school</u>, <u>regional charter school or cyber charter school</u>.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
