7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1501.8(a) and (n) of the act of March 10,
10	1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
11	added March 27, 2020 (P.L.62, No.13), are amended and the
12	section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
13	Section 1501.8. Pandemic of 2020(a) This section applies
14	only to the 2019-2020 school year as a result of the [global
15	pandemic declared by the World Health Organization on March 11,
16	2020] <u>pandemic of 2020</u> .

18	(m.1) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the following shall
19	apply to as a result of the pandemic of 2020:

1 <u>(1) Subsection (c) (3) shall apply to the 2020-2021</u> 2 <u>school year.</u>

(2) For the 2020-2021 school year, each school entity 3 shall adopt and follow a protocol for deep, regular cleaning 4 and sanitization in each school building that complies with 5 the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control and 6 Prevention and ensures that custodial staff are provided with 7 8 appropriate cleaning materials and personal protective 9 equipment. Each school entity shall post the adopted protocol 10 on its publicly accessible Internet website. (n) As used in this section, the following words and phrases 11 12 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless 13 the context clearly indicates otherwise: "NIMS assessment." An assessment based on the National 14 Institute for Metalworking Skills standards. 15 16 "NOCTI exam." A National Occupational Competency Testing 17 Institute exam. "Pandemic of 2020." The global pandemic declared by the 18 19 World Health Organization on March 11, 2020. 20 "School entity." Any school district, intermediate unit, area career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter 21 22 school or regional charter school a child attends in order to 23 fulfill the compulsory attendance requirements of this act.

24 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
