## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in commercial drivers, further providing for type of driving certification requirements. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1609.1 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 1609.1. Type of driving certification requirements. 8 \* \* \* 9 10 (c) Medical qualification requirements. -- In order to satisfy the medical qualification requirements of this section, an oral 11 fluid drug test shall be administered by a medical examiner, in 12 1.3 lieu of a urine test, to an individual who: 14 (1) certifies that the individual operates or expects to 15 operate a commercial motor vehicle in nonexcepted interstate commerce or nonexcepted intrastate commerce; 16 17 (2) certifies that the individual is unable to produce a 18 sufficient urine sample to complete the urine test due to a

- 2 (3) submits a medical record verifying, to the
- 3 <u>satisfaction of the medical examiner, that the individual has</u>
- 4 <u>the medical condition.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
