## AN ACT

9	hereby enacts as follows:
10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
12	section to read:
13	Section 2002-I. Drug, alcohol and polysubstance use, abuse and
14	overdose reporting.
15	(a) Duty to report An institution of higher education
16	shall collect, post and periodically update on the publicly
17	accessible Internet website of the institution of higher
18	education the following information relating to each campus of
19	the institution of higher education:
20	(1) The number of fatalities due to drug, alcohol or

- 1 polysubstance abuse by students.
- 2 (2) The number of emergency calls related to alcohol,
- 3 drug or polysubstance abuse by students and specificity as to
- 4 <u>each type of abuse.</u>
- 5 (3) The number of emergency transports of students to
- 6 <u>local hospitals secondary to the emergency calls.</u>
- 7 (4) Data regarding emergency calls for events in which
- 8 Narcan was administered to students, but no further treatment
- 9 <u>was provided.</u>
- 10 (5) The count of Narcan distributed by the institution
- of higher education to students.
- 12 (6) The number of the events involving drug, alcohol or
- 13 <u>polysubstance abuse by students that are considered to be</u>
- 14 under a medical amnesty policy of the institution of higher
- 15 education.
- 16 (7) The number of events involving drug, alcohol or
- 17 polysubstance abuse by students occurring at the same
- 18 <u>address</u>.
- 19 (b) Definition.--For purposes of this section, an
- 20 "institution of higher education" means a State-owned university
- 21 that is part of the State System of Higher Education, a State-
- 22 related university, a community college that is a member of the
- 23 Pennsylvania Commission for Community Colleges and an
- 24 independent or private college or university that receives an
- 25 appropriation or money from the Commonwealth.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
