## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds 5 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 6 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and 7 supervision of insurance carried by such companies, 9 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 10 repealing existing laws," in casualty insurance, providing 11 for COVID-19 care coverage. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known 16 as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended by adding a section to read: 17 18 Section 635.8. COVID-19 Care Coverage. -- (a) A health 19 insurance policy or government program covered under this 20 section that is offered, issued or renewed in this Commonwealth 21 shall include coverage for, and waive cost-sharing requirements

related to, medically necessary COVID-19 diagnosis, COVID-19

- 1 treatment and COVID-19 prevention.
- 2 (b) This section shall expire one year after termination or
- 3 <u>expiration of the COVID-19 disaster emergency.</u>
- 4 (c) The following words and phrases when used in this
- 5 section shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection
- 6 <u>unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 7 "Cost-sharing." The share of costs covered by the patient,
- 8 including, but not limited to, deductibles, coinsurance and
- 9 copayments or similar charges. The term does not include the
- 10 payment of health insurance policy premiums.
- 11 <u>"COVID-19." The novel coronavirus as identified in the</u>
- 12 <u>COVID-19 disaster emergency.</u>
- 13 "COVID-19 diagnosis." In vitro diagnostic and antibody tests
- 14 <u>authorized or approved by the United States Food and Drug</u>
- 15 Administration for COVID-19 in a manner which complies with the
- 16 rules, regulations or guidelines established by the Centers for
- 17 Disease Control and Prevention. The term does not mean testing
- 18 required for employment.
- 19 "COVID-19 disaster emergency." The declaration of disaster
- 20 <u>emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at</u>
- 21 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of
- 22 <u>disaster emergency.</u>
- 23 "COVID-19 prevention." Injectable medications, biologicals
- 24 or immunizations authorized or approved by the United States
- 25 Food and Drug Administration for COVID-19 in a manner which
- 26 <u>complies with the rules, regulations or guidelines established</u>
- 27 by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- 28 "COVID-19 treatment." Medical therapeutics approved by the
- 29 United States Food and Drug Administration for COVID-19 in a
- 30 manner which complies with the rules, regulations or guidelines

- 1 established by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.
- 2 "Government program." Any of the following:
- 3 (1) The Commonwealth's medical assistance program
- 4 established under the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21),
- 5 known as the Human Services Code.
- 6 (2) The Commonwealth's Children's Health Insurance Program
- 7 under Article XXIII-A of this act.
- 8 <u>"Health insurance policy." A policy, subscriber contract,</u>
- 9 <u>certificate or plan issued by an insurer that provides medical</u>
- 10 or health care coverage. The term does not include:
- 11 (1) Accident only.
- 12 <u>(2) Credit only.</u>
- 13 (3) Long-term care or disability income.
- 14 (4) Specified disease.
- 15 (5) Medicare supplement.
- 16 (6) Tricare, including a Civilian Health and Medical Program
- 17 of the Uniformed Services (CHAMPUS) supplement.
- 18 (7) Fixed indemnity.
- 19 (8) Dental only.
- 20 (9) Vision only.
- 21 (10) Workers' compensation.
- 22 (11) Automobile medical payment under 75 Pa.C.S. (relating
- 23 to vehicles).
- "Insurer." An entity that holds a valid license by the
- 25 Insurance Department with accident and health authority to issue
- 26 a health insurance policy and governed under any of the
- 27 following:
- 28 (1) This act, including section 630.
- 29 (2) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364), known
- 30 <u>as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.</u>

- 1 (3) 40 Pa.C.S. Chs. 61 (relating to hospital plan
- 2 <u>corporations</u>) and 63 (relating to professional health services
- 3 plan corporations).
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
