16	(a) General ruleExcept in cities of the first and second
17	class, the chief, superintendent or commissioner of police and
18	other ranking officers in a political subdivision of the
19	Commonwealth who [have been removed from] are not members of
20	bargaining units under the act of June 24, 1968 (P.L.237,

No.111), referred to as the Policemen and Firemen Collective
Bargaining Act, [by rulings of the Pennsylvania Labor Relations
Board] shall receive not less than the same dollar increase
including fringe benefits excluding overtime and festive holiday
pay as received by the highest ranking police officer
participating in the bargaining unit.

7 (b) Definition.--As used in this section, the term

8 "bargaining unit" means a collective bargaining unit as provided

9 <u>under the Policemen and Firemen Collective Bargaining Act.</u>

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
