## AN ACT

10	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

7	<u>§ 5901. Definitions.</u>
8	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
9	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
10	context clearly indicates otherwise:
11	"System." The Pennsylvania Amber Alert System, the Missing
12	Endangered Person Advisory System (MEPAS) and the Green Alert
13	<u>System.</u>
14	"Veteran-at-risk." A veteran, as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. §
15	7202 (relating to definitions), who is known to have a physical
16	or mental health condition that is related to the veteran's
17	service and is at special risk of harm or injury.
18	<u>§ 5902. Pennsylvania Amber Alert System.</u>
19	The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish and maintain
20	the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System to assist in the recovery of
21	abducted children through prompt notification to the general
22	public, appropriate law enforcement authorities and other public
23	agencies.
24	<u>§ 5903. Missing Endangered Person Advisory System (MEPAS).</u>
25	The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish and maintain
26	the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System to assist in the
27	recovery of missing persons who are at special risk of harm or
28	injury, through prompt notification to the general public,
29	appropriate law enforcement authorities and other agencies.
30	<u>§ 5904. Green Alert System.</u>

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1	The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish and maintain
2	the Green Alert System to assist in the recovery of missing
3	veterans-at-risk through prompt notification to the general
4	public, appropriate law enforcement authorities and other
5	agencies.
6	<u>§ 5905. Duties of Pennsylvania State Police.</u>
7	The Pennsylvania State Police shall establish such protocols
8	and procedures as are necessary for the effective operation of
9	each system and shall educate and inform local law enforcement
10	agencies and the public with regard to the availability of each
11	system.
12	<u>§ 5906. Prohibited use of alert systems.</u>
13	The transmission, broadcast or other communication of a
14	public alert, other than through the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
15	System, the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System or the
16	<u>Green Alert System, intentionally, knowingly, recklessly or</u>
17	negligently purporting to be made by, with or through the
18	authority of the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System, the Missing
19	Endangered Person Advisory System or the Green Alert System, is
20	prohibited and shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more
21	<u>than \$5,000.</u>
22	<u>§ 5907. Use of Missing Endangered Person Advisory System and</u>
23	<u>Green Alert System.</u>
24	<u>The Pennsylvania Missing Endangered Person Advisory System</u>
25	and the Green Alert System shall be operated by the Pennsylvania
26	State Police. Activation may be requested by law enforcement
27	agencies when public assistance is considered expedient to the
28	recovery of a missing individual believed to be at special risk
29	of harm or injury. The ability of law enforcement agencies to
30	independently notify or request assistance from the public shall
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1	not	be	impaired	nor	restricted	in	any	way.

2 <u>§ 5908.</u> Coordination with other jurisdictions.

3 (a) Pennsylvania Amber Alert System.--The Pennsylvania State

4 Police shall coordinate with the authorities of the various

5 states and the Federal Government that are responsible within

6 their respective jurisdictions for the recovery of abducted

7 children to establish and execute the procedures appropriate to

8 the effective fulfillment of its responsibilities relating to

9 the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System.

10 (b) Pennsylvania Missing Endangered Person Advisory System

11 and Green Alert System. -- The Pennsylvania State Police shall

12 coordinate with the authorities of the various states and the

13 Federal Government that are responsible within their respective

14 jurisdictions for the recovery of missing individuals believed

15 to be at special risk of harm or injury to establish and execute

16 the procedures appropriate to the effective fulfillment of its

17 responsibilities relating to the Pennsylvania Missing Endangered

18 Person Advisory System and the Green Alert System.

19 <u>§ 5909. Assessment of cost.</u>

20 Unless the court finds that undue hardship would result, in

21 addition to any other cost imposed by law, a cost of \$25 shall

22 <u>automatically be assessed on each person convicted, adjudicated</u>

23 <u>delinquent or granted Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition</u>

24 (ARD) of the offenses named in this section. The cost shall be

25 forwarded to the Commonwealth and used by the Pennsylvania State

26 Police to establish and maintain the Pennsylvania Amber Alert

27 System and apply to the following offenses:

12	<u>§ 5910. Immunity.</u>
13	(a) Media immunityOwners, licensees, operators and
14	employees of any communication medium, including, but not
15	limited to, telephone, radio, television, newspaper, digital
16	communications networks or global communications networks, shall
17	be immune from civil liability for their good faith conduct
18	while participating in accordance with this chapter.
19	(b) Good Samaritan immunityAny person who provides,
20	obtains or attempts to provide or obtain assistance for a child
21	who is the subject of a Pennsylvania Amber Alert System notice,
22	a person who is the subject of a Missing Endangered Person
23	Advisory or a veteran-at-risk who is the subject of a Green
24	Alert shall be immune from civil liability for acts or omissions
25	in providing or obtaining or attempting to provide or obtain
26	assistance except for acts or omissions intended to cause harm
27	and for which the law does not recognize justification or that
28	constitute gross negligence or willful, wanton or reckless
29	<u>conduct.</u>
30	Section 2. Repeals are as follows:
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(1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
 paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of 35
 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59.

4 (2) The act of November 24, 2004 (P.L.1270, No.153),
5 referred to as the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System Law, is
6 repealed.

7 Section 3. The addition of 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59 is a 8 continuation of the act of November 24, 2004 (P.L.1270, No.153), 9 referred to as the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System Law. The 10 following apply:

11 Except as otherwise provided in 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59, (1)12 all activities initiated under the Pennsylvania Amber Alert 13 System Law shall continue and remain in full force and effect 14 and may be completed under 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59. Orders, 15 regulations, rules and decisions which were made under the 16 Pennsylvania Amber Alert System Law and which are in effect 17 on the effective date of this section shall remain in full 18 force and effect until revoked, vacated or modified under 35 19 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59. Contracts, obligations and collective 20 bargaining agreements entered into under the Pennsylvania 21 Amber Alert System Law are not affected nor impaired by the 22 repeal of the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System Law.

(2) Except as set forth in paragraph (3), any difference
in language between 35 Pa.C.S. Ch. 59 and the Pennsylvania
Amber Alert System Law is intended only to conform to the
style of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes and is not
intended to change or affect the legislative intent, judicial
construction or administration and implementation of the
Pennsylvania Amber Alert System Law.
