## AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 1 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), 2 entitled 'An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 4 5 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 11 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 20 21 commissions shall be determined, ' implementing the addition of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 22 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 23 24 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 26 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 27 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 28 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 29 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," in 30 31 Office of Attorney General, further providing for legal 32 advice and civil matters.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

1 hereby enacts as follows:

2	Section 1. Section 204 of the act of October 15, 1980
3	(P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is
4	amended by adding a subsection to read:
5	Section 204. Legal advice and civil matters.
6	* * *
7	(c.1) Reimbursement for costs of collectionAll costs of
8	collection of debts, taxes and accounts due to the Commonwealth
9	incurred by the Attorney General must be paid before the
10	liability is extinguished unless collection costs are discharged
11	by operation of law. The costs of collection shall be added to
12	the amount of the liability and shall constitute a lien against
13	the real or personal property of the person liable. Costs of
14	collection may not exceed 3% of the principal amount of the
15	debt, taxes or accounts due to the Commonwealth. The unpaid
16	costs may be collected by the Attorney General or a private
17	collection agency. For purposes of this section, costs of
18	collection shall include only the following:
19	<u>(1) Lien filing costs.</u>
20	(2) Remuneration to the Attorney General to collect
21	debts, taxes and accounts due to the Commonwealth.
22	(3) Remuneration to a private collection agency
23	authorized by the Attorney General to collect debts, taxes
24	and accounts due to the Commonwealth.

26	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
