Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in vocational education, providing 5 for an PASMART online career resource center. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. - 2 INTERNET WEBSITE MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
- 3 INDUSTRY. THE WEBSITE, WHICH SHALL BE AVAILABLE NO LATER THAN
- 4 THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR, shall at a
- 5 minimum include an online database of the following:
- 6 (1) Postsecondary pathways and options.
- 7 (2) Career and technical education and workforce
- 8 opportunities.
- 9 <u>(3) Career pathways.</u>
- 10 (4) Data and statistics on employment opportunities and
- 11 <u>compensation</u>.
- 12 <u>(5) Statewide and regional articulation agreements.</u>
- 13 <u>(6) Other relevant career resources.</u>
- 14 (b) The online database shall be easily accessible by
- 15 students, parents, educators, school officials and the general <--
- 16 public. The Department of Education PARTICIPATING STATE AGENCIES <--
- 17 may utilize existing resources or clearinghouses available from
- 18 other agencies to compile the clearinghouse information.
- 19 (c) The Department of Education PARTICIPATING STATE AGENCIES <--
- 20 shall explore the possibility of Federal or private funding to
- 21 support the clearinghouse.
- 22 (d) The Department of Education, at least annually, shall <--

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- 23 <u>update the online database.</u> THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
- 24 INDUSTRY, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND
- 25 THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, SHALL ENSURE THAT THE
- 26 CLEARINGHOUSE IS UPDATED ANNUALLY.
