## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in human trafficking, further providing for civil causes of action. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 3051(a)(2) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 § 3051. Civil causes of action. 8 9 (a) General rule.--\* \* \* 10 11 (2) An individual who is a victim of the sex trade may 12 bring a civil action in the court of common pleas of the 13 county where the individual resides or where any of the 14 alleged violations of this chapter occurred against a person 15 that: 16 recruits, profits from or maintains the victim 17 in any sex trade act; 18 (ii) abuses or causes bodily harm to the victim in

- 1 any sex trade act; and
- 2 (iii) knowingly advertises or publishes
- 3 advertisements for purposes of recruitment into sex trade
- 4 activity.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
