7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 1605 of the act of March 10, 1949
10	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
11	amended by adding a subsection to read:
12	Section 1605. Courses of Study* * *
13	(d) (1) Beginning with those students graduating from a
14	public high school at the end of the 2018-2019 school year, and
15	continuing in each school year thereafter, a student who
16	successfully completes a course in personal financial literacy
17	during grades nine through twelve shall be permitted to apply up
18	to one credit earned for successful completion of such course to
19	satisfy the student's social studies, family and consumer

1	science or mathematics, MATHEMATICS OR BUSINESS EDUCATION credit <
2	requirement for graduation, provided that the governing body of
3	the student's public high school shall have discretion to
4	determine the graduation credit requirement to which the credit
5	earned by the student shall be applied.
6	(2) As used in this subsection, the following phrases shall
7	have the meanings given to them in this subsection, unless the
8	context clearly indicates otherwise:
9	"Personal financial literacy" shall mean the integration of
10	various factors relating to personal financial management,
11	including understanding financial institutions, using money,
12	learning to manage personal assets and liabilities, creating
13	budgets and any other factors that may assist an individual in
14	this Commonwealth to be financially responsible.
15	"Public high school" shall mean a public school, including a
16	school within a school district, a charter school, a cyber
17	<u>charter school, a regional charter school or an area vocational-</u>
18	technical school, that offers twelfth grade.
19	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
