## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled 1 "An act relating to counties of the second class and second 2 class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 3 laws relating thereto," in special powers and duties of the county, further providing for markers on graves, memorial 5 certificates and headstones. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 2113(h) of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is 10 11 amended to read: 12 Section 2113. Markers on Graves; Memorial Certificates; 13 Headstones. -- \* \* \* 14 Each headstone shall contain his or her name and the 15 rank and organization to which he or she belonged or in which he
- or she served, in letters raised or cut in at least threesixteenths of an inch deep. The headstone shall be of either

- marble or granite and shall be placed or set in a concrete base 18
- 19 at least three feet deep, or if a headstone has been provided

- 1 for such grave by the United States Government, the county
- 2 commissioners shall provide the concrete base therefor, or if
- 3 lettering only on an existing memorial is desired by the family,
- 4 the county commissioners shall provide such lettering. An amount
- 5 charged for the concrete base may not exceed the sum of two
- 6 <u>hundred fifty dollars (\$250).</u>

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
