## AN ACT

5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3704 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3704. Obstruction to driving view or mechanism.
9	(a) Obstruction by personsNo person shall drive a vehicle
10	when it is so loaded, or when there are in the front seat such a
11	number of persons, exceeding three, as to obstruct the view of
12	the driver to the front or sides of the vehicle or as to
13	interfere with the driver's control over the driving mechanism
14	of the vehicle or whenever any person in the front seat is not
15	seated.
16	(b) Obstruction by animalsNo person shall drive a vehicle
17	while holding or attending to an animal on the driver's lap, or
18	allow an animal to be in the driver's immediate area, which

- 1 interferes with the driver's control over the driving mechanism
- 2 <u>of the vehicle.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
