## AN ACT

13	<u>§ 2191. Definitions.</u>
14	The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
15	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16	context clearly indicates otherwise:
17	"City." A city of the first class.
18	"Police department." A public agency of a city having

1	general police powers and charged with making arrests in
2	connection with the enforcement of the criminal or traffic laws.
3	"Police officer." A full-time or part-time employee assigned
4	to criminal or traffic law enforcement duties of a police
5	department of a city.
6	"Program." A retired police officer program established by a
7	police department of a city under section 2192(a) (relating to
8	retired police officer program).
9	<u>§ 2192. Retired police officer program.</u>
10	<u>(a) EstablishmentA police department may establish a</u>
11	program for retired police officers to return to work for the
12	police department for a period of not more than one year.
13	(b) StandardsFor a retired police officer to return to
14	work for a police department under a program, the retired police
15	<u>officer:</u>
16	(1) May not have any record of unacceptable behavior or
17	disciplinary action as an active police officer.
18	(2) Shall complete the training established under
19	subsection (c).
20	(c) TrainingNotwithstanding any other provision of law,
21	the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission
22	shall establish an eight-week training program for retired
23	police officers returning to work for a police department under
24	<u>a program.</u>
25	(d) Benefit implicationsNotwithstanding any other
26	provision of law, a retired police officer's participation in a
27	program shall not affect any benefits received from a municipal
28	retirement system.
29	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
