AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for drug-
- 3 free school zones.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 6317(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 6317. Drug-free school zones.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A person 18 years of age or older who is
- 10 convicted in any court of this Commonwealth of a violation of
- 11 section 13(a)(14) or (30) of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233,
- 12 No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 13 Cosmetic Act, shall, if the delivery or possession with intent
- 14 to deliver of the controlled substance occurred within 1,000
- 15 feet of the real property on which is located a public, private
- 16 or parochial school or a college or university or within 250
- 17 feet of the real property on which is located a recreation

- 1 center or playground or library or on a school bus, be sentenced
- 2 to a minimum sentence of at least two years of total
- 3 confinement, notwithstanding any other provision of this title,
- 4 The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act or other
- 5 statute to the contrary. The maximum term of imprisonment shall
- 6 be four years for any offense:
- 7 (1) subject to this section; and
- 8 (2) for which The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and
- 9 Cosmetic Act provides for a maximum term of imprisonment of
- 10 less than four years.
- 11 If the sentencing court finds that the delivery or possession
- 12 with intent to deliver was to an individual under 18 years of
- 13 age, then this section shall not be applicable and the offense
- 14 shall be subject to section 6314 (relating to sentencing and
- 15 penalties for trafficking drugs to minors).

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
