9	Section 1. Section 9121(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania

13	(b) Dissemination to noncriminal justice agencies and
14	individualsCriminal history record information shall be
15	disseminated by a State or local police department to any
16	individual or noncriminal justice agency only upon request.
17	Except as provided in subsection (b.1):

1 (1) A fee may be charged by a State or local police 2 department for each request for criminal history record 3 information by an individual or noncriminal justice agency, 4 except that no fee shall be charged to an individual who:

5 <u>(i)</u> makes the request in order to apply to become a 6 volunteer with an affiliate of Big Brothers of America or 7 Big Sisters of America or with a rape crisis center or 8 domestic violence program[.]; or

9 <u>(ii) makes the request to apply for or maintain a</u> 10 <u>volunteer position. If the individual makes more than one</u> 11 <u>request each 36 months, a fee shall be charged for the</u> 12 <u>second and subsequent requests.</u>

13 (2) Before a State or local police department 14 disseminates criminal history record information to an 15 individual or noncriminal justice agency, it shall extract 16 from the record all notations of arrests, indictments or 17 other information relating to the initiation of criminal 18 proceedings where:

19 (i) three years have elapsed from the date of20 arrest;

21 (ii) no conviction has occurred; and
22 (iii) no proceedings are pending seeking a
23 conviction.
