## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- 3 related offenses, providing for the offense of inciting
- 4 violence against law enforcement officer.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5503.1. Inciting violence against law enforcement officer.
- 10 (a) Offense defined. -- A person commits a felony of the third
- 11 degree if the person willfully advocates violence against one or
- 12 more law enforcement officers that is likely to incite or
- 13 produce violence.
- (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 15 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 16 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 17 "Law enforcement officer." A person who by virtue of the
- 18 person's office or public employment is vested by law with a

- 1 duty to maintain public order or to make arrests for offenses,
- 2 whether that duty extends to all offenses or is limited to
- 3 specific offenses, or any person on active State duty pursuant
- 4 to 51 Pa.C.S. § 508 (relating to active duty for emergency). The
- 5 term shall also include any member of any park police department
- 6 of any county of the third class.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
