## AN ACT

| 7                | Section 1. Short title.   |
| 8                | This act shall be known and may be cited as the Video Camera  |
| 9                | Surveillance in Child Day-Care Facilities Act.  |
| 10               | Section 2. Definitions.   |
| 11               | The following words and phrases when used in this act shall   |
| 12               | have the meanings given to them in this section unless the  |
| 13               | context clearly indicates otherwise:  |
| 14               | "Child day care." Care in lieu of parental care given for   |
| 15               | part of a 24-hour day to a child under 16 years of age away from  |
| 16               | the child's home. The term does not include care in lieu of   |
| 17               | parental care given to a child under 16 years of age in a place   |
| 18               | of worship during religious services.   |
| 19               | "Child day-care center." Any premises in which child day  |

care is provided simultaneously for seven or more children who
are not relatives of the provider, regardless of which article
of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public
Welfare Code, applies to it.

5 "Department." The Department of Human Services of the6 Commonwealth.

7 "Facility." Any of the following:

(1) Child day-care center.

(2) Family day-care home.

"Family day-care home." A home in which child day care is provided at any one time to four, five or six children who are not relatives of the provider of the child day care and which is required to be registered under the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code.

15 Section 3. Video camera surveillance systems.

16 (a) Duty to install and maintain.--Each facility shall 17 install and maintain video camera surveillance systems that meet 18 or exceed the specifications for such systems as established by 19 regulation of the department.

(b) Regulations.--The department shall promulgate regulations that provide specifications for video camera surveillance systems in facilities and standards for the use of such systems.

(c) Inspections.--The department may conduct inspections offacilities to investigate compliance with this act.

26 Section 4. Applicability.

This act shall apply to facilities that commence operations after the effective date of this section.

29 Section 5. Effective date.

30 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
