## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and 17 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation 18 19 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 20 determined," in powers and duties in general, further 21 providing for departmental reports. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 24 hereby enacts as follows:
- 25 Section 1. Section 504 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 26 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended to
- 2.7 read:

- 1 Section 504. Departmental Reports.--(a) The head of each
- 2 administrative department and each independent administrative
- 3 board and commission shall, not later than October first of each
- 4 even-numbered year, report in writing to the Governor concerning
- 5 the condition, management, and financial transactions, of the
- 6 department, board, or commission; such reports shall, except
- 7 where impracticable, be for the two-year period ending May
- 8 thirty-first of the year in which they are made. Each
- 9 departmental administrative board and commission, and each
- 10 advisory board and commission, shall, not later than September
- 11 first of each even-numbered year, report in writing to the head
- 12 of the department of which such board or commission is a part.
- 13 All such reports shall be attached as exhibits to the report
- 14 made by the head of the department to the Governor.
- 15 Except as otherwise in this act specifically provided, the
- 16 reports required by this section shall be in lieu of all other
- 17 reports heretofore required by law to be made by the several
- 18 administrative departments, boards, and commissions, either to
- 19 the Governor or to the General Assembly.
- 20 (b) Reports required under subsection (a) shall:
- 21 (1) contain a thorough assessment of the weaknesses and
- 22 <u>risks within each administrative department and each independent</u>
- 23 administrative board and commission that could negatively affect
- 24 the ability of the department or board or commission to respond
- 25 to a future emergency in this Commonwealth; and
- 26 (2) detail the actions necessary to address or otherwise
- 27 <u>resolve the weaknesses and risks within each administrative</u>
- 28 department and each independent administrative board and
- 29 commission.
- 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
