3	(b) Transfers from Department of Human ServicesThe		
4	following functions, duties and entities of the Department of		
5	Human Services shall be transferred to the department:		
6	(1) Employment and training programs funded under Part A		
7	of Title IV of the Personal Responsibility and Work		
8	Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-193,		
9	<u>42 U.S.C. § 601 et seq.).</u>		
10	(2) Employment and training programs under section 6(d)		
11	of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 (Public Law 88-525, 7		
12	<u>U.S.C. § 2105(d)(4)).</u>		
13	(3) The program established under section 405.1B of the		
14	act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human		
15	<u>Services Code.</u>		
16	(c) Functions to be consolidatedThe functions transferred		
17	to the department under subsections (a) and (b) shall be		
18	consolidated with similar functions of the department within the		
19	department into division, section or other organizational entity		
20	devoted to workforce development. The Governor shall appoint a		
21	Deputy Secretary for Workforce Development. The deputy secretary		
22	shall have the powers and perform the functions and duties		
23	transferred to the department under subsections (a) and (b) and		
24	other such functions and duties authorized by the Governor.		
25	(d) Office of Vocational RehabilitationThe department and		
26	the Department of Labor and Industry shall enter into a		
27	memorandum of understanding under which the services provided		
28	<u>under Title I of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Public Law 93-</u>		
29	112, 29 U.S.C. § 701 et seq.), other than section 112 of the		
30	Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 732) or part C of the

1	Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 741) that relate to
2	vocational rehabilitation services are, to the maximum extent
3	practicable, provided by the department.
4	(e) Documentation required for Federal programsThe
5	department shall provide any necessary data, documentation or
6	verification needed by the Department of Labor and Industry or
7	the Department of Human Services which may be necessary to
8	effectuate the transfers under subsections (a) and (b).
9	Section 903. State Apprenticeship and Training Council.
10	The State Apprenticeship and Training Council as provided for
11	in section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604, No.304),
12	known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is hereby placed
13	and made a departmental board in the Department of Community and
14	<u>Economic Development.</u>
15	Section 1111. Membership on the State Apprenticeship and
16	Training Council.
17	In place of the membership of the Deputy Secretary of the
18	Department of Labor and Industry on the State Apprenticeship and
19	Training Council under section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961
20	(P.L.604, No.304), known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act,
21	the Deputy Secretary for Workforce Development shall serve as an
22	ex officio member of the council but shall not be entitled to
23	vote, except that in the event of a tie vote, the Deputy
24	Secretary for Workforce Development shall have the right to cast
25	the tie-breaking vote.
26	Section 2. Section 3 of the act of July 14, 1961 (P.L.604,
27	No.304), known as The Apprenticeship and Training Act, is
28	repealed to the extent that it is inconsistent with this act.
29	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
