AN ACT

Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled "An act providing for access to public information, for a designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, 3 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for 4 procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 7 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in 9 procedure, further providing for exceptions for public 10 11 records. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 708(b)(6) of the act of February 14, 2008 14 15 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, is amended to 16 read: 17 Section 708. Exceptions for public records. 18 Exceptions. -- Except as provided in subsections (c) and 19

(d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under

3	(6) (i) The following personal identification
4	information:
5	(A) A record containing all or part of a
6	person's Social Security number, driver's license
7	number, personal financial information, home,
8	cellular or personal telephone numbers, personal e-
9	mail addresses, employee number or other confidential
10	personal identification number.
11	(B) A spouse's name, marital status or
12	beneficiary or dependent information.
13	(C) The home address of a law enforcement
14	officer or judge.
15	(D) The name and home address of a juror.
16	(ii) Nothing in this paragraph shall preclude the
17	release of the name, position, salary, actual
18	compensation or other payments or expenses, employment
19	contract, employment-related contract or agreement and
20	length of service of a public official or an agency
21	employee.
22	(iii) An agency may redact the name or other
23	identifying information relating to an individual
24	performing an undercover or covert law enforcement
25	activity from a record.
