AN ACT

Amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), entitled "An act relating to public works contracts; providing for 2 prevailing wages; imposing duties upon the Secretary of Labor 3 and Industry; providing remedies, penalties and repealing 4 existing laws," further providing for definitions. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 2(5) of the act of August 15, 1961 8 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage 10 Act, is amended and the section is amended by adding a paragraph to read: 11 12 Section 2. Definitions. -- As used in this act--13 14 (5) "Public work" means construction, reconstruction, 15 demolition, alteration and/or repair work other than maintenance 16 work, done under contract and paid for in whole or in part out 17 of the funds of a public body where the estimated cost of the total project is in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars 18

(\$25,000), but shall not include <u>school safety and security</u>

- 1 <u>improvements or</u> work performed under a rehabilitation or

- 4 (11) "School safety and security improvements" means
- 5 construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration or repair
- 6 work performed to enhance or improve school safety and security,
- 7 which is:
- 8 (i) recommended or identified by a school safety and
- 9 security assessment performed under Article XIII-B of the act of
- 10 March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code
- 11 of 1949;
- 12 (ii) paid for in whole or in part from money provided under
- 13 section 1306-B of the Public School Code of 1949; or
- 14 (iii) identified in the criteria developed by the school
- 15 safety and security committee under section 1303-B of the Public
- 16 School Code of 1949.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
