AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, in environmental protection, providing
- for polystyrene food container prohibition.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

- 2 § 4301. Purpose.
- 3 The intent of this chapter is to reduce the adverse
- 4 <u>environmental impact of polystyrene food containers by</u>
- 5 prohibiting a food establishment from dispensing prepared food
- 6 to a customer in a polystyrene food service container.
- 7 § 4302. Definitions.
- 8 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 9 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 10 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 11 "Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
- 12 <u>the Commonwealth.</u>
- 13 <u>"Food establishment." All sales outlets, stores, shops or</u>
- 14 other places of business located within this Commonwealth which
- 15 operate primarily to sell or convey food directly to the
- 16 <u>ultimate consumer</u>, which food is predominately contained,
- 17 wrapped or held in or on packaging. The term shall include, but
- 18 not be limited to, any place where food is prepared, mixed,
- 19 cooked, baked, smoked, preserved, bottled, packaged, handled,
- 20 stored, manufactured and sold or offered for sale, including,
- 21 but not limited to, any fixed or mobile restaurant, drive-in,
- 22 coffee shop, cafeteria, short order cafe, delicatessen,
- 23 luncheonette, grill, sandwich shop, soda fountain, tavern, bar,
- 24 cocktail lounge, nightclub, roadside stand, prepared food take-
- 25 out place, industrial feeding establishment, catering kitchen,
- 26 commissary, grocery store, public food market, food stand or
- 27 <u>similar place in which food or drink is prepared for sale or for</u>
- 28 service on the premises or elsewhere, and any other
- 29 establishment or operation, including homes, where food is
- 30 processed, prepared, stored, served or provided for the public

- 1 for charge.
- 2 "Polystyrene food service container." As follows:
- 3 (1) A single-use polystyrene foam food service container
- 4 <u>such as a cup, bowl, plate and clamshell-style container in</u>
- 5 <u>addition to a foam cooler that is not encased in another</u>
- 6 <u>material</u>.
- 7 (2) A single-use polystyrene solid plastic food
- 8 <u>container such as a cup, bowl, plate, clamshell-style</u>
- 9 <u>container, cutlery, straw and cup lid.</u>
- 10 "Prepared food." Food or beverage prepared for public
- 11 consumption by a food establishment using any cooking or food
- 12 preparation technique. The term does not include raw or uncooked
- 13 meat, fish or eggs, provided for public consumption without
- 14 further food preparation.
- 15 "Retailer." A person that purchases or receives products
- 16 from any source for the purpose of sale to a consumer.
- 17 § 4303. Prohibition.
- 18 (a) Food establishment.--A food establishment is prohibited
- 19 from:
- 20 (1) Dispensing prepared food in or on a polystyrene food
- 21 <u>service container.</u>
- 22 (2) Selling, giving or providing eating utensils or
- 23 straws composed of polystyrene.
- 24 (b) Retailer. -- A retailer is prohibited from selling, giving
- 25 or providing a polystyrene food service container except for:
- 26 (1) Meat trays.
- 27 (2) Egg cartons.
- 28 (3) Packing materials.
- 29 § 4304. Complaints.
- 30 The department shall prescribe a procedure for a person to

- 1 file a complaint with the department for a violation of this
- 2 <u>chapter</u>.
- 3 § 4305. Compliance.
- 4 The department shall develop and maintain a publicly
- 5 accessible Internet website with all of the following:
- 6 (1) A description of the information necessary to comply
- 7 <u>with the prohibition under section 4303 (relating to</u>
- 8 <u>prohibition</u>).
- 9 (2) A description of the procedure to file a complaint
- 10 with the department for a violation of the prohibition under
- 11 <u>section 4304 (relating to complaints).</u>
- 12 <u>§ 4306. Regulations.</u>
- 13 The department may promulgate rules and regulations necessary
- 14 to implement the provisions of this chapter.
- 15 <u>§ 4307. Penalties.</u>
- 16 (a) Imposition. -- The department may impose a civil penalty
- 17 in the following amounts for a violation of this chapter:
- 18 (1) For a first violation, \$500.
- 19 (2) For a second violation, \$1,000.
- 20 (3) For a third or subsequent violation, \$2,000.
- 21 (b) Payment.--Any civil penalty collected under subsection
- 22 (a) shall be paid to the department.
- 23 (c) Local law.--This chapter shall preempt any ordinance or
- 24 resolution passed or adopted by any political subdivision that
- 25 is effective on, before or after the effective date of this
- 26 chapter to the extent that the ordinance or resolution conflicts
- 27 or is inconsistent with the provisions of this chapter.
- 28 § 4308. Applicability.
- 29 This act shall apply to transactions consummated after
- 30 December 31, 2019.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
