## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in fostering independence through education, further providing for definitions, for fostering independence waiver program, for outreach and for report. 4 5 6 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 9 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 2601-K of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended by adding definitions to read: Section 2601-K. Definitions. 13 14 The following words and phrases when used in this article 15 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16 context clearly indicates otherwise: \* \* \* 17 "Kinship care." The care of a child by a <del>relative or other</del> 18

kinship caregiver of the child who has an

- 4 relationship with a child and assumes legal responsibility for
- 5 the child. The term includes any of the following:

- 7 (2) An aunt or uncle of the child.
- 8 (3) A family friend of the child.
- 9 <u>(4) Any other relative or individual that legally</u>
- 10 <u>assumes responsibility for the child.</u>
- 11 "KINSHIP CAREGIVER." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 12 <u>(1) IS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE; AND</u>
- 13 (2) LIVES WITH AND HAS LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR A CHILD.
