## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in pupils and attendance, prohibiting unsafe operation of school buses and school vehicles.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	Section 1361.1. Unsafe Operation of School Buses and School
13	<u>Vehicles(a) No individual may consume food or beverages or</u>
14	<u>operate a cellular telephone while operating a school bus or a</u>
15	school vehicle on any trafficway when the school bus or school
16	vehicle is in motion and is transporting one or more children.
17	(b) The prohibition in subsection (a) does not apply when
18	the school bus or school vehicle is parked in a safe area off of
19	<u>a trafficway as defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to</u>
20	definitions), the consumption of food or beverages is necessary

1	for a medical condition, or the operation of the cellular
2	telephone occurs during an emergency situation.
3	(c) A person who violates this section commits a summary
4	offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine
5	<u>of not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than one hundred</u>
6	dollars (\$100). The fine shall be three hundred dollars (\$300)
7	if the violation causes a vehicular accident.
8	(d) For purposes of this section:
9	<u>"Cellular telephone" shall mean a cellular, analog, wireless</u>
10	or digital two-way communication device that:
11	(1) Requires the operator to dial numbers or operate
12	manually.
13	(2) Includes radio-telephone communications used in cellular
14	telephone service, personal communication service or the
15	functional equivalent of a radio-telephone communications line
16	used in cellular telephone service or a personal communication
17	service.
18	The term does not include a two-way radio, a citizens band radio
19	<u>or a citizens band radio hybrid.</u>
20	"Emergency situation" shall include an occasion where a call
21	<u>is made on a cellular telephone to:</u>
22	(1) An emergency system response operator or 911 public
23	safety communications dispatcher.
24	(2) A hospital or emergency room.
25	(3) A physician's office or health clinic.
26	(4) An ambulance or fire department rescue service.
27	(5) A fire department or volunteer fire department.
28	(6) A police department.
29	(7) A school district building or central dispatch.
30	(8) Emergency roadside assistance agencies or towing or

- 2 "School bus" shall have the same meaning as defined in 75
- 3 <u>Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to definitions).</u>
- 4 <u>"School vehicle" shall have the same meaning as defined in 75</u>

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
