AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45), entitled
 "An act establishing a uniform construction code; imposing
 powers and duties on municipalities and the Department of
 Labor and Industry; providing for enforcement; imposing
 penalties; and making repeals," in exemptions, applicability
 and penalties, providing for residential building
 construction defect remedies.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of November 10, 1999 (P.L.491, No.45),
- 11 known as the Pennsylvania Construction Code Act, is amended by
- 12 adding a section to read:
- 13 <u>Section 904.</u> Residential building construction defect remedies.
- 14 <u>(a) Repairs required.--The builder of new or rehabilitated</u>
- 15 residential building construction sold or leased and registered
- 16 <u>in this Commonwealth shall repair or correct, at no cost to the</u>
- 17 purchaser, a defect, including a water infiltration issue,
- 18 <u>structural issue or any other problem, which substantially</u>
- 19 impairs the use, value or safety of the residential building

- 1 construction and may occur within a period of two years
- 2 following the actual delivery by the builder or the builder's
- 3 <u>designee of the residential building to the purchaser.</u>
- 4 (b) Action permitted. -- If a defect is brought to the
- 5 <u>attention of the builder within two years of actual delivery to</u>
- 6 the purchaser of the residential building, the following shall
- 7 apply:
- 8 (1) The builder shall have six months from the date of
- 9 <u>the notice of the defect to make the repair or correction.</u>
- 10 (2) If the repair or correction is not completed within
- six months from the date of the notice under paragraph (1),
- the purchaser shall be entitled to file an action for
- 13 <u>compliance with this section in a court of common pleas with</u>
- 14 <u>jurisdiction over the residential building.</u>
- 15 (3) If the action for compliance under paragraph (2) is
- 16 <u>adjudicated in favor of the purchaser, the builder shall be</u>
- 17 <u>liable for 150% of the cost of the repair or correction.</u>
- 18 (c) Applicability. -- This section shall not apply to a defect
- 19 that is cosmetic or covered by a warranty.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall apply to residential buildings
- 21 that were delivered within two years of the effective date of
- 22 the addition of section 904 of the act.
- 23 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
