7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

10	(a) Offense definedIt shall be prohibited to carry or
11	cause or allow to be carried a dog on the hood, roof, truck bed
12	or any other external section of a vehicle on a public road in
13	this Commonwealth.
14	(b) GradingUpon conviction, a violation under this
15	section shall be a summary offense punishable by:
16	<u>(1) A fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$150 for a</u>
17	first violation.
18	(2) A fine of not less than \$150 nor more than \$300 for

1 <u>a second violation.</u>

2	<u>(3) A fine of not less than \$300 nor more than \$500 or</u>
3	imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both, for a third
4	or subsequent violation.
5	(c) ExceptionThis section shall not apply to a dog
6	transported in a secured insulated cage or container which is
7	designed to facilitate the safe transportation of a dog and will
8	prevent the dog from being exposed to outside weather conditions
9	and from falling, jumping or being thrown from the vehicle.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
